Comments by Keith

My earliest memories are of living at Waldron, Kansas. I was told that the old troll lived under the bridge between our house and the school house. (I really believed this) but it didn't keep me from running off. I went the opposite direction to Mary and Dad Swiggart's place. Later I learned that Mary would hang a tea towel on the clothes line to let Mother know that I was over there. When Mary would bake bread, she would make a small loaf for me.

We went to Dalton Valley one time (I don't know why) and a dirt storm came up. We headed for home and the car died up on the hill. Daddy took the chains out of the car and laid them somewhere on the car. The car finally started. We turned around and went back to the school. We spent the night there with several other families.

Daddy and Uncle Guy Fullmer were putting up prairie hay. I was playing in the hay loft and fell out onto a mound of hay. I ran about 1/4 of a mile, to ask them if the fall would kill me.

When Uncle Ralph worked for the Hineman farm. A Negro couple by the name of Bill and Ethel Brisco also worked for them, and would bring Uncle as far as our place. Later Dean decided he wanted a Negro brother and painted me black with either stove black or soot. I think to say Mother was unhappy is an understatement.

Just Mother and I went hunting one day. She shot a rabbit. As I ran to get the rabbit, Mother shot again - about 3 feet in front of me lay a rattlesnake. Mom's shot had killed it.

On Sunday Daddy would make biscuits and gravy for breakfast. Then we all went to church. We had to really be sick to miss church.

I remember the day Mother got a gas-powered Sears washing machine (her first machine). It was exciting. When it broke down Mother would order the parts and I would help her fix it.

A red fox had a den across the draw and up on the flat east of the barn. If the fox was out early in the morning eating, Daddy would say there will be a storm today. The fox was always right. If the fox was out eating in the evenings we would have a storm at night. Daddy and the fox were always right.

THE LAST 50 YEARS By Laura

I gained employment with Ma Bell (Telephone Company) 3 weeks before we graduated. Married Keith February 20th of '53. I had a car wreck July 3rd of '53. The doctor didn't expect me to survive the first two weeks. The ordeal left me with one leg shorter than the other.

Our children came in rapid suction, (five in six years) along with raising them. I joined an E.H.U. Group, taught Sunday School, Bible School, and was Sunday School Secretary.

Thirteen years in into our marriage we went into business for our self. I became the secretary, bookkeeper & gopher. Soon after cooking for 8 hired men was added to my duties.

On December 13^{th} of '72 Keith had a heart attack & was completely disabled for 18 months. He also became a diabetic during this time.

In 1990 the Dr's were successful in operating on the back side of the heart & Keith had a quadruple bypass.

Somewhere along the way I learned to upholster and refinish furniture. I knit, crochet & quilt (self - taught). Helped with March of Dimes & headed up St. Jude's Walk-A-Thon.

In looking back over the last 50 years, I'm glad I took this roller coaster ride with all curves, valleys & hills. It has been a good and happy 50 years. God has blessed me with a full and hectic life.

My children are Renita, she has given us 2 grandchildren and is a dietitian at Hamilton Co Hospital. Sonia is a cosmetologist and lives in Lake Hauasu, AZ. Keitha has 3 children and is bookkeeper for Dr. Dozing in Dighton. Eugene has 2 children and is Assistant City Manager, Fire Chief and First Responder in Dighton. Asalea has 3 children and is an EMT and works as a Paraprofessional at Dighton Grade School.

Our ten grandchildren have been a constant joy & inspiration to us with 8 of them living in Dighton and the other 2 of them just a two-hour drive away. We have had the pleasure of watching them grow up and being involved in their accomplishments and problems.

It is hard to believe that 50 years have slipped by, and I've missed out on the thrills and sorrows of each of your lives. Also, I've lived just 25 miles from the old school. I've lost contact of all of you & was so shocked to learn that so many of us are already gone.
