







## Elijah Snow and Phebe R. Lamberton

Elijah Clapp Snow was born in Brookfield, Mass. on October 24, 1826. Parents are David Snow and Salome Bartlett.

Phoebe Lamberton was born in West Brookfield, Mass. on January 4, 1829. Parents are Samuel and Lucy Lamberton.

Elijah married Phoebe on June 23, 1857. They had five children, George F., Wilbur, Lulu (Lucy), Eva and Fred I.

They moved to Texas in the fall of 1878, where they stayed for seven years. Then they moved to Alemena, Kansas where Elijah and Phoebe resided until their deaths. Elijah died October 14, 1914. Phoebe died April 10, 1912. Both were converted in their youth and joined the Free Methodist Church. They were very active in church until their death.
