Descendants of Obadiah Wilson

Generation No. 1

1. OBADIAH¹ WILSON was born 1758 in New Jersey, and died 1826 in Licking Co. OH. He met (1) ? PEGG? Abt. 1786. She was born Abt. 1766, and died Abt. 1809. He married (2) REBBECA 1809. She was born Abt. 1775 in MD. He married (3) REBECCA Abt. 1810. She was born Abt. 1775 in MD.

Notes for OBADIAH WILSON:

Obadiah was on the PA line S40708 American Rev. He applied in May 1818 in Licking Co. OH. for Rev. Pension Pay. It was granted. He went into the service in the Fall of 1776 and was there 3 years and 10 months. Getting out around 1780. Signing affidavit's for his Pension were Benjamin Pegg, Jefferson Co. OH., Elias Pegg, Franklin Co. OH and Thomas Henderson of Gurnsey, Co. OH

Obadiah was a private under Col. McCoy's regiment of the 8th Reg. Penn. Line. He enlisted in Pittsburgh, PA. 1776 for 3 years. He was in 10 months extra. and his discharge was signed by Col. Broadhead and Col. Byard. He was not engaged in any Battle of consequence during the time of his service. except a skirmish with the Indians above Pittsburgh. On records from PA. pay vouchers for Obadiah as a Serjt. One is for 2nd Battalion 1781-1783. 2nd no rank certificate 11,355 issued 25 Mar 1786 and the 3rd is same with Sgt. All 3 in Washington Co. PA. issued 4 Nov 1784 cert. 929. I don't know how these connect as they are at a later date.

There was a Catherine Pegg m. Jacob Little in Newark, OH, Licking Co. Also a Thomas Wilson b. 1760 York co. PA m. Nancy Ann Pegg daughter of Daniel Pegg. They were all in Washington Co. PA and in Peters Twp. Thomas was in the War with Obadiah. Peggs also came from New Jersey. I think we are connected some way as 2 of them signed the war papers for Obadiah.

The Peggs came to NJ before William Penn (about 1670) and were Quakers. They were all in the Rev. together.

1783 Nottingham Twp Wash Co. PA has Obadiah married on Tax report Has 1 cow and Value is \$4

1785 Nottingham Twp Wash Co. PA. was Obadiah Wilson on Tax list. (no Amount given) Also, John and Daniel Wilson, all married. This would overlap the time in service. Must have been on call. 1785 would make Rebecca only 10 years old, so there was evidently another wife. I wonder if she might have been a Pegg, sister of the boys.

1790 in Peters Twp. Wash. Co. PA, was Obadiah with 1 son under 16 and 4 female. He must have gotten married around 1781. This would make 3 sisters if they all lived (possible) plus Suel. Between 1790 and 1800 I have no information.

In 1813 Suel, 1st son, was in Medina Co. OH in the war of 1812. Medina was Portage CO. until 1812.

In 1814 Suel was in Licking Co. OH. I assume Suel and Obadiah came the same time.

Dec 1816 Bennington Twp, there is a record for Obadiah as being an auctioner for Henry Iles desc. He was paid \$3.00.

1818 in Newton Twp, where Obadiah filled his pension Papers.

22 Sep 1822 Mary Ann Twp Obadiah bought a shovel plough for \$2. 05 from sale of Henry Kleiver.

Desc

1826 in Mary Ann Twp, Obadiah was also on the Tax Records. He probably died there

1850 in Rev. papers Rebecca stated Obadiah died about 25 years ago.

There is a small gap between William b. 1808 and Amelia b. 1812 I think this is when the first wife died. As John went with Suel to IL I think they were full brothers

There is a George with all our names. John had a George, Lewis had a George, also sons of Suel had George's in their line. Would one think this George on the 1850 census close to the family in Licking Co. not be an Uncle. Also John named his second child George and named his first Lewis. We have none of the children before John b. 1806 except Suel, so we could have lots more relatives

More About OBADIAH WILSON:

Military service: Bet. 1776 - 1785, Washington Co. PA

Notes for ? PEGG?:

I do not know who Obadiah's wife was for Suel. Could have been Pegg. He might have been married again as there were several years from 1783 till 1806 (John). There would have been lots of children as I have no children from 1789 (Suel) until John in 1806. There is a George with them b. 1890 in MD. in Licking Co. OH. 1850. He was 60. It also said Suel was b. in NH. so he might have been just moving a lot. Census had him 1890 in PA.

As for the George, I am sure a grandfather, bother or some way we have a George older as everyone has a George in their family.

Notes for REBECCA:

Rebecca was in Washington Twp Licking Co. in 1830 with Lewis, James, William, Hannah, Amelia, Peggy and one under 5. So guess there is another sister. (No names but the same ages as we have).

1840 in Eden Twp Rebecca is with William, (no little one so maybe she died or was someone elses. Next page is Lewis (Willson) and our John (Willson).

1850 Eden Twp is Rebecca 75 b. MD, and William 44 b. OH. Lewis was Also. James had gone to Knox Co. Just north of Eden Twp.

William in 1830 was next to Rebecca and he had no family. In 1840 I have no record of William or Rebecca. In 1850 is Rebecca 75 b. MD, William 44 b. OH. He was really b. 1808 according to Obadiah's Rev. Recd.

2. SUEL² WILSON (OBADIAH¹) was born May 07, 1789 in Washington Co. PA or New Hampshire, and died July 17, 1857 in Jay Co., IN. He married ESTER BURNETT Abt. 1815 in Licking Co., OH. She was born Abt. 1797 in N.Y., and died Aft. April 02, 1862 in Jay Co. IN.

Notes for SUEL WILSON:

In the History of Median Co. OH., War of 1812., shows Suel Wilson, Co. K, 15th U.S.V.R.C.,e Dec 16, 1862; died

The official twp. records of 1813 shows Sewell Wilson in Licking Co. OH.

We have a will of Suel written 27 June 1857, probate Sept 1857. In it he tell all the children and also the ones that went to IL. It is through that, we found the rest. Through the biography of Johnson Lorenzo we found that Suel went to IN 1846. Our John shows one child b. Mar. 1846 in OH. and the next b. 1848 Jay Co. IN. This would make John and Suel going the same time from OH. to IN.

On the 25th of March, 1839, a contract for building the new Baptist (Alexander OH) meeting house, was made with Suel Wilson and Silas Burnett, the consideration being 600 dollars; 100 dollars down, 100 then the house was enclosed, 200 in Sept. and 200 in Jan. The house was build according to contract, and the basement was plastered and seated and became the home of the church for four years. Suel was Adm. on the death of Squire Burnett in 1831. The Burnett's came from Crawford co. PA. as Silas had to write back to PA to get a paper saying he was divorced before he could marry Cornedia. Ft. Wayne library

We have her will from Jay Co. IN. She left everything to her Son Judson C. Wilson the land and appurtenances Situated thereon, known as the Wilson Farm, lying in the Twp of Bearcreek in the Co. of Jay and State of IN. 2nd day of April in the year of our Lord 1862 Ester Wilson

On Suel's 1820 census Cornelia was the only child. I have born in NY on the 1850 census.

Silas was a carpenter and worked with Suel sometimes. I have where they had a contract together. They came to OH from Crawford Co., PA. In the Ft Wayne Library I found where he had to write here to prove he had gotten a divorce from his first wife.

Notes for STEPHEN LORENDUS WILSON:

I had the census for Stephen and his marriages but the rest was given to me by Clark Blake (he also has a Ralston in Adams Co. OH and I do also). I may be relation two ways. Ha)

Stephen was a Captain in the civil war. Also a (School Teacher) It was Company C. Thirty ninth Indiana Volunteer Infantry. on his papers it said he was 6'2 1/2" tall. His son Darwin Fremont was 6' tall.

Stephen and Ann had son Cassius M. died Nov 25 1857 age 1 yr, 3 mo. 1 day old.

Also a daughter Ella V. died 20 Sept 1855 age 11 Months. Both in the same cem. as Stephen.

On the 1860 census of Jay Co. IN, Stephen had 1. Victor S. 8 b. IN. (1852) 2. John B. 7 b. IN (1853)

3. Darwin Fremont b. IN (1859) and Anne Armentrout 28 can't read and Pauper (under remarks)

She was probably the housekeeper with Ann already dead.

Darwin Fremont b. 22 Jun 1859 Jay Co. IN m. Verona Mary Horner daughter of John Glentzer, Sr. from Switzerland in 1753 to Berks Co., PA and later serving in the Revolutionary War.

Darwin graduated from Univ. of Rolla, MO. (killed in a train accident) Mary Horner was b. 12 Aug 1874 (Dau. of Joseph Culton Horner and Arminda Hester Pugh) 20 Dec 1960.

Notes for JOHNSON LORENZO WILSON:

From the Portrait in Henry Co. IL. written in 1885 is this information.

Johnson Lorenzo Wilson, residing on Section 27, located adjoining the town of Galva, is a native of Ohio. He was born in St. Albans Twp., Licking Co., that State, Aug 2, 1832. The parents of Mr. Wilson of this sketch were Seuel and Esther (Burnett) Wilson. He was born in New Hampshire, and died in Jay County, IN in July, 1857, having removed to Ohio, that State, in 1846. He was a farmer by occupation, and in his religious belief was: from the time he attained the age of manhood, a member of the Baptist Church. His father, grandfather of our subject, was born in New Jersey, was of English extraction and a soldier of the Revolutionary War; was a farmer by occupation and died in Ohio. Seuel Wilson was a soldier in the War of 1812, Mr. Wilson's parents lived and died in Indiana.

J.L. Wilson, of whom we write, received his education principally in Ohio. He removed with his parents into Indiana, and from there came to this State, in 1854, stopping in Peoria County. He remained there until spring of that year, when he moved near Elmwood, Knox County, this State, where he followed the occupation of farming for three years. At the expiration of this time, in 1857, he came to Galva, (IL) in the neighborhood of which village he rented land and was occupied in its cultivation for two years. Previous to moving here he had purchased land, which during the last few years mentioned he improved as time would permit. At first he purchased 80 acres, which he afterward sold and purchased another 80 east of the present village of Galva. He subsequently bought 40 acres more, and then sold the 120 acres, and with the proceeds purchased 100 acres adjoining the present village of Galva, the same being located on Section 27, Galva Township, and on which he at present resides.

Mr. Wilson was united in marriage April 11, 1861, with Miss Amanda M. Herbert. She has born in Lewistown, Fulton Co., IL in 1842. She has borne him seven children: Lillian M., Ralph L., Fred H., Walter, Myrtie E., Katie and Ethel L. Mr. and Mrs. Wilson, together with their children, Lillian and Ralph, are members of the Baptist Church. Politically, Mr. Wilson indorses the party which advocates prohibition.

3. JOHN² WILSON (*OBADIAH*¹) was born Abt. 1806 in PA., and died September 01, 1877 in Hartford Twp. Adams Co. IN. He married ISABELLE CARROLL Bef. 1830 in Licking Co. OH, daughter of JOHN CARRELL and REBECCA RYAN. She was born Abt. 1811 in OH, and died Bef. 1870 in Adams Co. IN..

Notes for JOHN WILSON:

On census John and Isabell are both b. in PA 1850. 1860 John in VA. and Isabell in OH. 1870 John is 64 and 300 Val. and b. Penn. Isabelle is 59 b. Ohio and Amelia (Phemelia) 16 b. IN. This last census goes along with the death report of Louis Wilson (Son)

John lived in Licking Co. OH from an early age. John and Sewell both came to Indiana about 1846-47. Suel's son stated in his biography they came in 1846. John had Rachel b. OH Mar 1846 and Thomas b. IN 1848. So this would be correct.

Isabell was in 1870 census and died before John died 1877.

We have a probate of John, 1 Sep 1877, in Adams Co. IN. Probate. It did not name the heirs, however the inventory at the sale sold a lot of the possessions to his children. His suit cost \$17.50 for burial.

Thomas J. Wilson (Grandson) was reimbursed for the suit.

There was an Elizabeth Perry requested papers on John's death. No address and no records of her. Who was she. Now on any census.

On John and Isabell's 1840 census in Licking co. Eden Twp. there was 1 boy 5-10 (George 6) 1 boy 10-15 (Lewis 10) John Willson (Wilson) 30-40 and 2 girls under 5 (Rebecca 4 and Emily 2) and Isabella was 20-30. No record of an Elizabeth.

There was also Lewis Willson (Wilson) and he was 20-30. William and Rebecca was on the page before them as Wilson.

Gertrude Darst, a granddaughter of John and Isabel, told us they were buried in White Oak Cemetery with no markers. Rebecca, Rachel, Thomas and Francis M., and Lewis were all buried their with stones. Some were broken and the last time I was there Lewis's stone was broken. He is real close to the younger children's stones or lack of now. The cemetery is back off the road and cows can get into it.

On the vital records of Lewis He has John Wilson born in PA and Izabell Carroll born in OH. I feel these are right. More on Izabell under her name.

Notes for ISABELLE CARROLL:

According to records of John Carrell in Licking Co. Oh: Our Isabell is the right age etc to be his youngest daughter. Bible records etc show all the other children but she was b. ab. 1811 and they didn't have that but they did have a girl on the census, to 10 in 1820 making her the right age.

John was a son of James Carrell and Margaret , in PA. John was born on 26 Mar 1775 in PA. He died before 1826 in Licking Co. OH as the tax list 1826 had Rebecca's name and not John.

There is a will: James Ryan - Recorded 23 Dec 1812 (FC Rockefeller) I give and bequeath after the term of three whole years be expired after my death unto Rebecca Carroll my second daughter now living the sum of one Dollar to be paid unto her by Ambrose Ryan.

Estate: Orphans Court, Allegheny Co. PA 1789-1829 LDS FILM # 866288 (FCR) June 17 1997 the final accounting for the estate of John Carter describes John Carroll and his wife Rebecca (the late Rebecca Carter) as administrators

Rebecca married John Carter in 1790. John died before 26 Jun 1794 in PA. They had the following children 1. Thomas Carter, b. 1791 Allegheny Co. PA died Same place 31 Aug 1802. 2. Ryan Carter b. 16 Feb 1793 Allegheny Co. PA. died 1813 Jefferson Co. OH.

Mary Hagan has all of this and the children b. in Allegheny Co. PA. Allegheny was made off Washington Co. PA in 1788 Part of it was Peter's Twp where Obadiah Wilson lived also. I have not found it yet but believe they came to Jefferson Co. OH and to Licking Co. OH together.
